## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION**

### **YOU MUST READ THESE TERMS CAREFULLY.**

**All organizations and groups registering with the Ministry of Sport and Community Development shall adhere to basic rules of conduct. You agree and are aware that it is prohibited to engage in conduct or share content which:**

- is openly offensive and fosters or incites racism, bigotry, hatred or physical violence of any kind against groups or individuals;
- is offensive, threatening, obscene, disrespectful, indecent, defamatory, libellous or causes harassment in another way or supports such undesirable forms of behaviour;
- encourages sexual or violent exploitation of persons;
- comprises of the sharing of nudity, violent or indecent images;
- publishes information which poses a risk to the protection of personal data or security;
- contains or endorses information which, to the best of the member's knowledge, is false or misleading;
- infringes intangible property rights (to trademarks, designs, patents or copyright), especially which constitutes or promotes illegal or unauthorized copies of copyright works of other persons, e.g. pictures, logos, proposals, ads.
- promotes or supports unlawful acts or plans or contains instructions on illegal acts, e.g. making or buying illegal weapons, illegal drug activities
- contains photographs or videos of other people, which have been published without the consent of those people;
- infringes, or attempts to infringe, in particular privacy laws, contract law or the rights of third parties;

## **You agree to and are aware of the following:**

- Treat all participants in your sport as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Confirm that the information set out in the registration form is accurate in all material respects and that you will inform us of any changes immediately.
- Registrants agree to allow the Ministry to use any photographs or other images of them taken at Ministry of Sport and Community Development events or activities for promotional purposes and are aware that they may be taken by other members and posted on social networking sites or elsewhere over which the Ministry has no control. Where the photograph is on the Ministry's website and is deemed offensive by you then upon being informed the Ministry will use its discretion to remove it or otherwise but is under no obligation to do so.

## **Reporting**

The Registrant agrees to submit accurate activity, financial and statistical reports relevant to the registered organization on an annual basis and/or as requested by the Ministry of Sport and Community Development.

## **Indemnity**

The Registrant agrees to guarantee and hold the Ministry harmless from any claim or demand, including reasonable legal fees, made by any third party due to or arising out of your breach of these Terms or arising from your negligence or breach of duty.

## **Privacy and Information Security Statement**

The Ministry of Sport and Community Development online and paper-based registration process requires you to provide an array personal information e.g. name, addresses etc. This information is required for registration, membership & volunteer purposes with the Ministry.

Full names and phone numbers etc. will be used on websites and newsletters where appropriate or necessary, e.g. Club Member or Club of the Year etc. The Ministry will not make any identifying information available to any other parties without consent unless required in the ordinary operation of the Club.

Only employees of the Ministry of Sport and Community Development will have access to your full registration information.

## **Where is the information held?**

All data is securely stored by The Ministry of Sport and Community Development and maintains a copy of the information locally as an exported file and in paper-based form. Your Personal Information is stored in a manner that reasonably protects it from misuse and loss and from unauthorized access, modification or disclosure.

## **Providing info to third parties**

The Ministry of Sports and Community Development will not give any registrants' information to any 3rd parties except if we are required by law. We will honour a lawful request by a government agency.

By signing your registration form you are accepting the Club Rules/Terms and Conditions.

The Ministry reserves the right to terminate your membership with immediate effect should you be found to breach these conditions.
