RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES 2024 FOLK THEATRE

FOLK PRODUCTIONS

PART 1- GENERAL

- (1) The National Anthem is compulsory and must be rendered before all productions. Five (-5) average points will be deducted for not playing the National Anthem.
- (2) Qualification, participation, adjudication procedures and related penalties will be assessed as outlined in the Overall Guidelines.
- (3) Folk Theatre productions numbers a minimum of twenty-five (25), and a maximum of seventy-five (75) persons, including accompanists.
- (4) Duration: Folk Theatre productions must run a minimum of 75 minutes and a maximum of 90 minutes. Clock will start with first sound or movement after National Anthem is completed.
- (5) Minus two (-2) average points will be deducted for every minute over or under the stipulated timeframe.
- (6) Minus five (-5) average points will be deducted for every person under the 25 minimum cast and accompaniment number.
- (7) Groups should note that extensive scene changes, unnecessary blackouts as well as the use of special effects such as ultra violet (UV) or black lighting can distract audiences and reduce the effectiveness of their performances. Only two blackouts are allowed for Folk Theatre Preliminaries if needed.

Special Awards

- (9) Special awards will be adjudicated by a panel as detailed in the Overall Guidelines. Scores will be awarded based on the average after the highest and lowest scores have been removed.
- (10) Best Original Written Script
 - i. This category is open to all original scripts qualifying for the finals of the competition.
 - ii. An original script is defined as: A script that has not been staged at any major festival or competition anywhere in the world and has not previously qualified for the finals of the Best Village Trophy Competition.
 - iii. Adaptations do not qualify for this prize.
 - iv. Original Scripts must be submitted to the Best Village Office no less than two (2) weeks before the start of the Finals in order to qualify for the Best Written Script Award.
 - v. The script with the highest average over 70% will be awarded the prize for Best Original Written Script
- (11) Other special prizes will be awarded for Folk Theatre:
 - i. Best Director and Best Directed Production
 - ii. Best All Round Performer Male
 - iii. Best All Round Performer Female
 - iv. Best Choreographer
 - v. Best Musical Director
 - vi. Best Musical Accompaniment
 - vii. Best Costume Designer and Best Costumed Show
 - viii. Best Representation of a Nation Building Theme
- (12) The following additional prizes will be awarded for the Folk Theatre Productions category:
 - i. Best Actor
 - ii. Best Actress
 - iii. Best Child Actor Male/Female (13 years and under)
 - iv. Best Dancer in Production
 - v. Best Vocalist in Production
 - vi. Best Choral Work
 - vii. Best Drumming Ensemble
